The Mow-In® is The Gravely® Tractor Club of America's annual tractor show and swap meet. You will see original and restored Gravely® tractors and attachments from past to present. The Mow-In is the largest Gravely® tractor event of the year. This year's show will be held at The Four Town Fairgrounds, 56 Egypt Rd, Somers, CT, 06071, May 15th & 16th with club hosts Timothy & Walter Mips.

General Information for Mow-In 2010®

Admission – Scantic Valley Antique Engine & Tractor Club will charge an ***ADMISSION fee of \$4*** and children under 16 are free. Exhibitors and Swap Meet vendors are free of charge. ***All are more than welcome to attend.***

Exhibitors – **The Gravely® Tractor Club** will provide two 40'x 80' tents to display tractors and attachments. Swap Meet activities are prohibited in these tents.

Swap Meet- Each vendor will be given an area by the Director who is in charge of this part of the show.

Awards – Awards will be presented in the form of plaques at the Banquet dinner or by mail if the individual of the award is not present. The awards are as follows, Oldest tractor, Most unusual tractor, Most unusual attachment, Outstanding modified restoration, Outstanding original condition, and Outstanding restoration, Best of show, and Club appreciation.

Security – Security will be provided by *The Scantic Valley Antique Engine and Tractor Club* including an overnight attendant.

Shirts – 2010 Mow-In® shirts will be available for purchase at the show which will feature Pierre LeBoutillier's 1934 hex axle tractor.

Raffle Tractor – There will be a raffle for a 1972 Commercial 10A 10HP tractor, Serial#79225, with a 30" deck. This tractor has been professionally restored by club member Brian Jennings.

Rules & Regulations:

Trademarks – In accordance with our trademark agreement with Gravely®, no one may sell any item carrying the Gravely® name except those items manufactured by Gravely® or exact reproductions of Gravely® items which are no longer available from the factory.

No advertising signs are permitted in our area of the show except those of the Club Host, Gravely® and the Gravely® Tractor Club of America.

No consumption of alcoholic beverages on the grounds at any time for any reason.

No selling of food or beverages on the grounds.

No operation of tractors outside the Gravely® area of the show and all operators must be completely qualified and capable of reaching all controls. Attachments shall not be engaged except with the approval of the Director – Safety is a Major Concern.
