The Mow-In® is the Gravely® Tractor Club of America's annual show and swap meet. You will see original and restored tractors and attachments. The Mow-In® is the largest Gravely® event of the year. This year's show will be held August 12, 13, & 14, 2011. The Gravely® Club meet host is Bill Gardner.

## **General information for Mow-In 2011®:**

**Admission** - *Admission is \$5.00.* Children under 12 are free. Exhibitors and Swap Meet vendors are free of charge.

**Exhibitors** - The Gravely® Tractor Club will provide a building to exhibit show tractors and attachments. Flea Market activities are prohibited in this building but welcomed near by.

**Awards** - They will be given in the form of plaques in ten categories. These awards will be presented at the Banquet or by mail.

**Flea Market** - Each vendor will be given an area by the Director who is in charge of this part of the show. There will be a \$10.00 charge to vendors who are not members of the Gravely® Tractor Club of America.

**Shirts** - 2011 Mow-In® tee shirts will be available for purchase at the show.

## **Rules and Regulations:**

**Trademarks** - In accordance with our trademark agreement with Gravely®, no one may sell any item carrying Gravely® name except those items manufactured by Gravely® or exact reproductions of Gravely® items which are no longer available from the factory. Samples of requested exceptions must be submitted to the club not less than 60 days before the Mow-In® so that these samples may be sent to the factory for their approval. Approval is not guaranteed. You must attempt this at your own risk. Nothing may be sold using the name Mow-In 2011® or Mow-In®. This name is trademarked and only items that solely benefit Gravely® Tractor Club of America will be permitted.

No advertising signs are permitted in our area of the show except those of the Host Club, Gravely®, and the Gravely® Tractor Club of America. No alcoholic beverages are permitted on the grounds at any time for any reason. No selling of food or beverages is permitted on the grounds. You may bring food for your own consumption, but no cooking is permitted. There will be authorized food concessions on the grounds.

No operation of tractors is permitted outside the Gravely® area of the show and all operators must be fully qualified and capable of reaching all controls. Attachments shall not be engaged except with the approval of a Director - **SAFETY IS OF PRIME CONCERN**
