Information

The Mow-In® is The Gravely® Tractor Club of America's Annual Tractor and Attachment Show and Swap Meet. You will see original and restored Gravely® tractors and attachments, many of which are rare and some may be one of a kind. The Mow-In® is the largest Gravely® event of the year. This year's show will be held at *Sam Yoder's Farm* in Houston, DE, on June 26 and 27, 2009. Your Gravely® Club host is Russell Yoder.

General Information for Mow-In 2009®

Admission - Admission, Display and Swap Meet are free of charge for all participants.

Exhibitors - **The Gravely® Tractor Club** will provide two large tents to exhibit show tractors and attachments. Swap Meet activities are prohibited in these tents but welcomed nearby.

Swap Meet - Each vendor will be given an area by the Director who is in charge of this part of the show.

Awards - Awards will be given in the form of plaques and will be presented at the Banquet dinner or by mail.

Security - Security will be provided by *Sam Yoder's Farm* for the duration of the show.

Accommodations and Attractions - See attached lists.

Demonstrations - Demonstrations will be held each day. If you wish to demonstrate a piece of equipment, a sign up sheet will be located at or near the registration table.

Tee Shirts - Commemorative Tee Shirts will be available for purchase at the Show.

Trademarks - In accordance with our trademark agreement with Gravely®, no one may sell any item carrying the Gravely® name except those items manufactured by Gravely® or exact reproductions of Gravely® items which are no longer available from the factory. Samples of requested exceptions must be submitted to the Club not less than 60 days prior to the Mow-In® so that these samples may be sent to the factory for their approval. Approval is not guaranteed. You may attempt this at your own risk.

Nothing may be sold using the name Mow-In 2009® or Mow-In®. These names are trademarked and only those items which solely benefit the Gravely® Tractor Club of America will be permitted.

No advertising signs are permitted at the show except those of the Host, Gravely® and the Gravely® Tractor Club of America.

No alcoholic beverages are permitted on the grounds at any time for any reason. There will be authorized food concessions on the grounds. You may bring your own food for consumption, but no cooking is permitted on the show grounds.

All tractor operators must be fully qualified and capable of reaching all controls. Attachments shall not be engaged except with the approval of a Director - **Safety is of prime concern.**

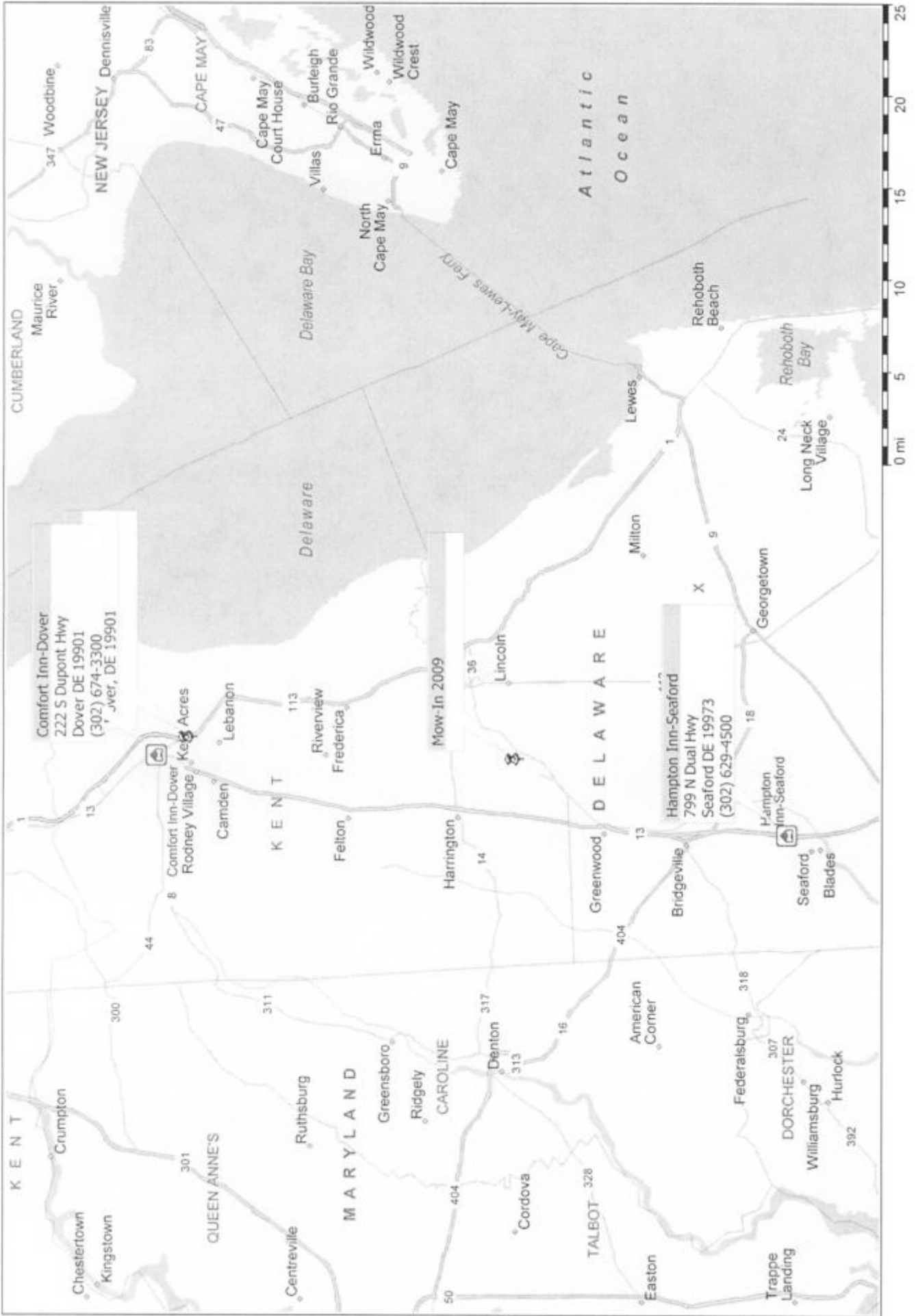

Directions to Sam Yoder Farm, 89 Hunting Quarter Rd., Houston, DE 19954

From the North – Rte. 1 South through Dover - continue South on Rte. 1/113 to Milford - Bear right and continue on Rte. 113 South into Milford - Turn Right onto Rte. 14 W - Turn Left (approx. 300 ft.) onto Williamsville Rd. - Continue on Williamsville Rd. to Hunting Quarter Rd., Turn Left onto Hunting Quarter Rd. - approx. 1 mile on Right to entrance Sam Yoder Farm.

From the South - Rte. 13 North to Greenwood, DE - Turn Right onto Rte. 16 E - 1 Traffic Light and Turn Left onto Shawnee Rd. (Rte. 36) - Follow Shawnee to Memory Road (approx. 5 miles) - Turn Left onto Memory Rd. and follow to Hunting Quarter Rd. - Turn Left onto Hunting Quarter Rd. - Immediate Left to entrance Sam Yoder Farm.
