

Application for a Gravely Tractor Club of America MOW-IN Site

In all cases - - - the show should be held in a geographic area close to the majority of the membership. This will ensure the club of a large attendance at the show. The show area should be the size of **four** football fields so that it will be large enough to set up two 40 X 80 tents and approximately 70 to 80 flea market areas.

There will be ONLY one show per year - - - and it shall be scheduled between May and October. The annual show shall be scheduled not less than one year in advance of the show date.

The Board of Directors is available - - - to help with any problems that would arise in planning of the show. A Mow-In outline is available from past Mow-In chairmen. Publicity will be in the *Gravely Gazette*, and also on the Registration Form mailed out to the membership. The Board of Directors must approve the site and date of the show.

Needed are - - - someone to be Chairman, along with a **local** club member willing to help with organizing the show. The Chairman should appoint a committee to help with all of the necessary work that goes into making the Mow-In a success.

Suggestion - - - The annual Mow-In will get better exposure and attendance if it is part of a larger event in your suggested area, such as another Antique Machinery Show or Tractor event.
